What an amazing day we had on Friday, taking part in the national ROAR project for Key Stage Two pupils. The children were brilliant, spending the day with new children in different classrooms. The ideas they came up with were absolutely brilliant - machines that can pick up rubbish from the sea and beach, vending machines that homeless people can put rubbish in and get food or clothes, and a vase that helps keep your flowers alive longer. Each house picked 2 winners and these then competed in the final presentation. We were joined by some of the Burgess HIII Lions - Sue and also Christine, who is the current President. They helped us to judge the final. Our winning team won by a landslide and we were really impressed with their design. It is a robot that can help elderly people, or people with a disability, that comes fully equipped with a camera to keep an eye on them and blue toothed so as to alert family or emergency services if needed. It can feed them, do chores and almost be a companion - we can't wait to see them in real life! The winning team will now put together a video presentation that will be sent off to the National Roar competition. The final is on Wednesday 3rd December and we will be joining online to see if we are a winner. A huge well done to all our children for taking part. 


