## JOB TITLE: Midday Meals Supervisor

RESPONSIBLE TO: Senior Midday Meals Supervisor

PURPOSE OF JOB: To supervise children during the lunch hour inside or outside. You may be required to lift tables and chairs at times.

### **JOB Description**

#### A. Supporting Pupils

- 1. Supervise and maintain good order amongst children during the lunch break both inside the school building; corridors and hall as well as outside in the playground
- 2. Ensure that lunches are eaten in a sociable and healthy environment
- 3. Encourage the children to eat their packed lunches and hot school meals, along with explaining the reasons for following a healthy diet.
- 4. Hygiene: Wash tables and sweep floors as children finish their lunches ready for the next sitting. Leave the class base clean and tidy for afternoon lessons following wet play
- 5. Ensure that the children move around the school in a safe manner during the lunch break.
- 6. Support and maintain a purposeful, orderly and supportive environment in accordance with Good Behaviour Policy
- 7. Support the day to day concerns/problems of children.
- 8. Understand and organise children and triage any problems, resolving minor issues and notifying other staff of any serious incidents (following the Good Behaviour Policy)
- 9. Encourage children to include each other during playtime showing respect for each other, using the school values of Bravery, Curiosity, Resilience, Community and Respect as a model for all the behaviour for both adults and children within the school.

#### B. Working with the School Staff

- Read and follow the London Meed Staff Code of Conduct and other School Policies as directed.
- 2. Liaise with and follow direction of class and senior teachers over concerns regarding individual pupil's behaviour or welfare.
- 3. Attend training as requested through self-review or directed through school improvement procedures
- 4. Discuss concerns observations and good news regarding individual children with the class teacher and/or senior staff where applicable.
- 5. Attend team meetings on request
- 6. Liaise with other team members to ensure all areas of playground are covered
- 7. Attend to minor injuries (see First Aid Policy) and/or refer more serious injuries to the First Aider on Duty.
