Dear Parents/Carers,

We have had a successful return to school and I have loved listening to children talk enthusiastically about their learning and new topics. Do remember that a termly overview for each year group can be found on our website under the "children" section.

On Thursday, we had a monitoring visit from an Advisor focusing on our school priority of Reading and Phonics. The progress we have made since our 2019 Ofsted visit is very evident and it is clear that reading has a high priority in our school.

We are currently reviewing children's attendance, our aim is to achieve an overall school attendance of at least 95%. Parents and Carers will be contacted if a child's attendance is low without good reason. Our intention is to support families to ensure good attendance. Please remember that our gates shut at 8.45am and children who are not in class for the register will be marked late.

Clubs will resume next week. Mrs Ann Dudding will be offering more places at Choir on a Thursday morning, before school. Please see further details below on how to sign up.

We were delighted to welcome so many prospective families to our Open Days last term. Just a quick reminder that the deadline for applying for a school place for children starting school in September 2023 is Sunday 15th January.


