

# LONDON MEED PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

## London Meed School Uniform Policy March 2025

We want our children to look smart when at school and feel proud to wear the London Meed uniform.

Our Uniform Policy is outlined below.

London Meed's uniform is not gender specific.

Please ensure that all items of clothing are clearly named.

- Dark green fleece, or jumper, or cardigan (these can all be with or without school logo)
- White shirt, polo shirt (with or without logo), or blouse
- Grey / black trousers, or skirt or pinafore dress, or grey / black shorts
- Grey / black jogging trousers or leggings can be worn in EYFS
- Green and white summer dress / shorts jumpsuit
- Grey, black or dark green tights
- White, grey or black socks
- Shoes should be a black and of a design your child can fasten. These can include trainers, but **they must be entirely black**. Please see below for examples of what is and is not acceptable.

**PE** - all children to come into school in their PE kit on their PE days

Yellow PE T-shirt with logo, or plain yellow t-shirt

Black PE shorts, or a black skirt

Black jogging trousers, or black leggings

Green hoodie with school logo, or green jumper or fleece

Black, grey, blue or white plimsolls or trainers

- Children are not allowed to wear open-toed summer sandals
- No jewellery to be worn, except watches or stud earrings. If earrings are worn they need to be taped up or taken out on PE days. If watches are 'Smart Watches' they must only be used for telling the time. Children may be asked to remove their watch if they are using other applications on it.
- Children are not permitted to wear nail varnish. If they continually arrive at school wearing nail polish, it may be removed by a member of school staff.
- Base layers are not allowed.
- Long hair needs to be tied back.
- Hair needs to be the child's natural colour. Hair dyeing is not permitted.
- Lost property will be available to look through in either of the main school corridors.
- Year 6 can wear 'Leaver's Hoodies' on PE days in the Autumn and Spring terms, and on any day after the conclusion of SATs tests in May.
- Children who are classed as Pupil Premium (entitled to the Free School Meal benefit or are classed as Looked After) will receive one jumper/cardigan/fleece, a PE T-shirt.

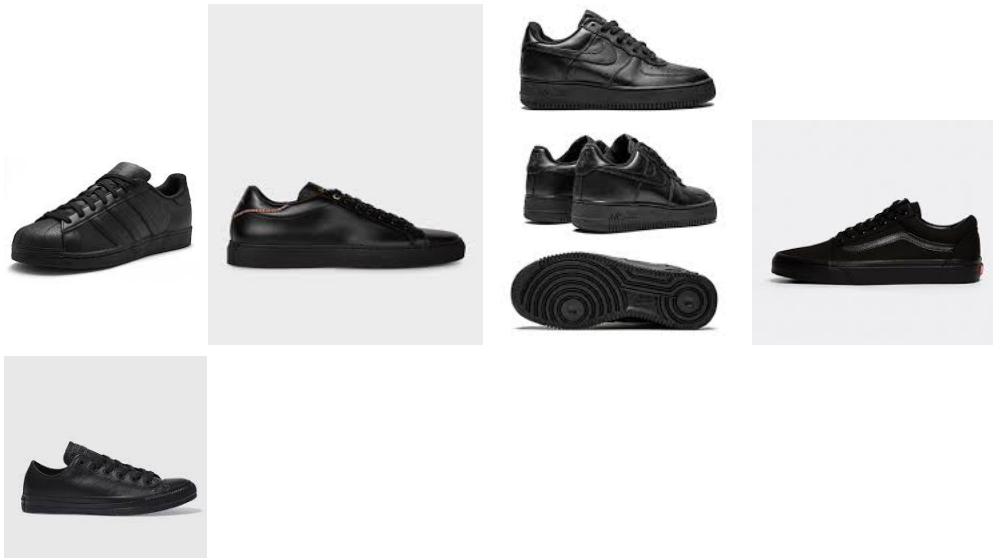
